
Four Patch Baby Quilt



Yardages:

3/8 yd for Four Patch A
3/8 yd for Four Patch B
2/3 yd alternating squares
1/3 yd inner border
5/8 yd outer border
1/3 yd binding
1 ½ yds backing

Use a 1/4" seam throughout.

Four Patch A
Cut (4) 2-1/2" x wof

Four Patch B Cut (4) 2-1/2" x wof^k

Alternating squares

Cut (4) 4-1/2" x wof. From these cut:

(31) 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" squares

Make (4) strip sets as shown below. Press toward the darkest fabric. Subcut into (64) 2-1/2" segments.



16 segments per strip

Inner border:

Cut (4) 2" x wof. From these:

Trim (2) to the length of the quilt top at this point.

Sew to each side.

Trim (2) to the width of the quilt top including the two side borders. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Outer border: 5"

Cut (4) 4=#2" x wof *

Measure and sew in the same order as you did for the inner border.

Binding:

Cut (5) 2-1/4" x wof.*
Sew with a 1/4" seam.

Make (32) four patch units

*wof - width of fabric
