Allow for the shrinkage that happens with quilting and then washing your completed project. Normal shrinkage is an average of 3% - 7%, depending on fabrics and density of your quilting.

GLUE BASTE mix well - 25% washable school glue with 75% hot water. Either dribble, brush, or spray onto batting & smooth fabric into place. Let dry before sewing.

Adult Wheelchair Quilt Kit

Gallon Ziplock bag - batting – DCQG iron-on label – a pair of Velcro straps & Patch set - your choices of fabrics

SPECIAL FEATURES (optional)


A – 10" Velcro Straps w/ Buckle attached on the back 4" from the top to secure around the armrests.

B - Large hand warming pocket, centered in the lap. (This could be lined with flannel or silky material.) Add a contrasting smaller pocket layered on top. (3-5 inches below the top)

C - Velcro patches on the back of the quilt (10" - 12" above the hem). This holds the quilt when wrapped behind the shins for warmth. (One on the front and one on the back of the quilt).

D - Rounded corners at the feet to prevent tangling with the wheels.

Add your personal touch for the recipient, if you choose; by placing the DCQG label with your name and date inside the top binding for them to find.



Over the Bar Walker Caddy Kit for Senior Homes & Rehabilitation Centers

Requested finished sizes at least 16” length x 19” wide - up to - 19” length x 21” wide

Gallon Zip Bag – Batting – DCQG iron-on label – fabrics of your choice

SPECIAL FEATURES

Caddy hangs over the horizontal crossbar for stability and easy assembly.

Secured to the vertical side bars of walker frame by your choice of ties, Velcro patches, large buttons, or big snaps. Magnets are not recommended near folks using a pacemaker.

Two deep pockets on one side (7” to 9” tall) can hold a notebook, magazine, book or tablet securely. This one should be between 13” to 14” wide. The remainder of the deep pocket width (3” to 4”) can be for glasses or pens.

Shallow pockets (3” to 5” tall) can be divided into 2 or 3 sections as you choose. Pockets can be strengthened by folding over or lined. Contrasting fabrics, trim, or bold stitching can help visually define the separate pockets.

SCRAPPY or FRANKEN-BATTING butt straight edges of batting pieces together. JOIN WITH A ZIGZAG STITCH using light colored thread. Cut to desired size for project.
